Italy is using diplomacy for education of their diplomats


Easy and few rules:

- a) You can vote (move) for yourself
- b) You can support someone (vote for someone else)
- c) You can disturb (cut) votes / supports
- d) Do nothing
- e) Transport / Convoy units

The player concentrating 18 of 34 cities (=core competences) wins - or who got the most cities after a fixed number of rounds.
